### ❖ **Session 1: 10:30 AM -2:30 PM**

#### Converging Hides and Leaving Found Hides

One of the challenges of multi-hide searches is when hides converge. Our canine partners then need to make decisions and sort out the odor picture. We need to recognize this in our dog's behavior and our dogs need to learn to navigate the puzzle. In addition, dogs need to decisively leave a found hide and search for additional hides.

### ❖ **Session 2: 3:30 PM-7:30 PM**

#### Containers and the Challenge of Distractors

Containers seem to be the bane of many nose work handlers. The introduction of distractors at the NACSW NW2 and AKC Advanced level adds challenges many teams have a hard time navigating. Most dogs enjoy running container searches, but their humans approach them with fear. In this workshop, we will discuss types and set-ups of containers, handling methods, the causes of false alerts and misses, navigating distractors, and other factors affecting container searches. Working teams will get in-the-moment coaching and recommendations on how to turn their container searches into a positive and successful experience.
